Main Student Record Types

- Three new record types
 - Student Standing (FS)
 - Student Attributes- Effective Date (FD)
 - Student Attributes- No Date (FN)
- Mostly existing elements
- Smaller Student Demographic (GI)
- No more Student Attendance (GK)

Effective Dates

- Present on FS and FD records
- Provide continuous values for elements where needed by ODE
- New record when values change
- Open versus Closed record
- Report first day of school to end of reporting period- cumulative for year
- Example improvements: OE funding, yearend attendance

Student Standing (FS)

- Relationship of student to district
- Attending and Assigned Building
- How Received (Student Status)
- Sent Reason (A/H Indicator) x 2
- Received and Sent IRNs

Student Standing (FS)

- Tuition Type
- Attendance Counts x 3
- Effective Dates
- Multiple SSIDs (rare)
- Percent of Time split
- Admission/Withdrawal date/reason
 - Clarification of Admission Date meaning
