## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- General Information
  - What has changed since 2007
    - NRE – deleted – records required based on enrollment dates
    - NLP – not deleted, however, ODE will not be looking for Reading and Writing test records for a student with an “L” LEP status code
    - MOV – can now be used for students moving **in or** out of the district
  - *Building IRN - Spring Test Administration*
    - Non-Accelerated or First Time Accelerated students -
      - Building IRN where student is enrolled, regardless of where student actually took the test
    - Previously Accelerated students –
      - Building IRN of where the student would be enrolled for that accelerated grade-level

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- General Information
  - *Fiscal Year Began Ninth-Grade* (Student Attendance Record)
    - Identifies the first time a student was identified as a 9<sup>th</sup> grader in any Ohio public school
  - For the transfer student
    - From another Ohio public school - it does not mean when they would have been a 9<sup>th</sup> grader in **your** district
    - From other than an Ohio public school – it is based on the grade-level she/he enters your district

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- General Information
  - Student enrolled in any part of a test window report all required test records
  - NLP can only be used when both are true
    - Less than 180 days **and**
    - Not previously exempted from one administration
  - Achievement and OGT Test Records
    - No combination of ALT and STR for same administration
    - Two sets of scores – ALT and STR
      - Achievement – STR over ALT for spring administration
      - OGT – whatever is processed first
    - If test records are missing – no ADM funding in FY09 (ORC 3313.03 & 3314.08)

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- Preschool Assessments (ASQ/SE, ECO & GGG)
  - Report results from spring administration
  - Some ASQ/SE and ECO from fall administration
    - Enrolled but withdrawn prior to October Count Week
  - Resident district reports for MRDD students with disabilities
  - Who Reports ESC vs. District
    - Student receiving instruction at district – district reports
    - Student receiving related services only at ESC – ESC reports
    - Student receiving instruction at ESC only – ESC reports
  - ECO *Score Element* – 1 through 7 are valid scores; not just 1, 3, 5, & 7 (see R&R)

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- Achievement
  - Spring administration dates are April 21<sup>st</sup> to May 9<sup>th</sup>
    - Any student enrolled during this test window will need to have all required test records submitted regardless of when the test administration began in your district
  - *Reason Test Not Taken Element*
    - Valid Option code "H" has been deleted (was only used for Grade 3 Reading)
      - With a pass reported on the fall administration reading test record, a spring administration reading test record is not required and should not be reported

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- Achievement – Accelerated Students
  - *Type of Accommodation Element*
    - Subject Accelerations
      - “Y4” must be reported on applicable accelerated-subject test records
        - » Applicable – grade level of test is higher than overall-grade level of student
    - Whole Grade Accelerations
      - “Y4” is optional, not required
  - *Grade Level of Student at Time of Test Element*
    - Subject Accelerations
      - Overall-grade level of the student as reported on Student Demographic Record
    - Whole-Grade Accelerations
      - Overall-grade level, which is = to the Accelerated-grade level

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- Achievement – Accelerated Students
  - *Test Grade Level Element*
    - Subject Accelerations
      - Grade level of the test required or a “non-existent” test (i.e., grades 9-12)
    - Whole Grade Accelerations
      - Overall-grade level, which is = to the Accelerated-grade level

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- OGT
  - Report test records from fall/spring administrations, and if taken, the previous summer administration (Summer 2007).
    - 1<sup>st</sup> time 10<sup>th</sup> Graders - Report all subject test records for students required to test
    - Retained 10<sup>th</sup> graders & 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Graders - Report test records for the subject tests taken or required to have been taken
  - *Test Required for Graduation Element*
    - For 11 & 12<sup>th</sup> graders, as well as retained 10<sup>th</sup> graders, report all test records again if there has been a change in this element

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- OGT
  - OGT *Graduation Alternative Element* (Student Attendance Record)
    - Reported for graduating students
    - Used only for one subject
  - Grad Issues\_Req\_Test Report – identifies students reported as graduates, who have not met the test graduation requirement

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- Proficiency & IEP Based Alt Assessment
  - No change from previous year instructions
    - Report **all five** test records, one per subject test
    - Most recent test result
- Graduation-Only (used to be Proficiency Only)
  - Report only when the student passes all subject tests and receives her/his diploma

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- Career Technical Education Assessments
  - Student Assessment (no change)
  - Industry Assessment (new)
    - Two elements
      - Type and Results
  - Reported for all Concentrators who took a test(s)

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- District Testing – Yearend
  - Report one record per district per grade level per test (includes DYS and Community Schools)
    - A record still required even if no tests administered
  - Only report non-state tests given across district
    - Includes local assessments

## Yearend Test Records – What to Report

- OTELA
  - Report results from current spring administration
    - Closed April 4th – later test administration close date
  - Required for all students with LEP Status = “L”, “M” or “Y”
  - Composite Performance Level Element
    - Last year – a score was reported and ODE derived the performance level
    - This year – no score and vendor is providing the performance level
    - Valid Option code “I” was recently added (R &R)

  - OAT
  - OGT
  - OTELA
- Grad Issues\_Req\_Test
- Gen Issues
  - Include other checks being conducted by ODE business centers
  - As related to Test Records
    - Alt Assessment reported but student has no disability
    - District Test Record – no missing report
- Another check of interest
  - Comparison of Test Vendor file and EMIS data
